**Capacity:** Note; 1 litre= 1000 millilitres

1. Make a list of 5 things that are sold in 1 litre containers.
2. Use a measuring jug or a 1 litrebottle/carton to measure 1 litre of water. Estimate and then measure whether each of these objects hold more than, less than or around 1 litre of water.
  - A Cup/ Bowl/ Saucepan/Jug/ Teapot
3. If 1 litre is 1000 millilitres, howmany millilitres are there in half a litre and a quarter of a litre.
4. Use a measuring jug to measure half a litre, like in Q2, estimate and measure whether these objects hold more than, less thanor around half a litre
  - A Cup/ Bowl/ Glass/ Ladle

Make up some **word problems** e.g "If there were 24 pencils in a pencil case but 8 were broken, how many good pencils were there in the pencil case?"  $24-8= 16$ .

You could login to Seesaw and upload your word problemfor Ms. Treacy to figure out!!
