Cut an apple in 5/6 pieces. 2. Put each piece in a separate bowl 3. Cover the pieces with lemon in one bowl, milk in another, baking soda, vinegar and something else in the other bowls. 4. Label your bowls. 5. Predict which will stop the apple from turning brown. 6. Let me know how you get on!
